The following tables show the % of pupils in primary schools broken down by Outstanding, Good, Requires Improvement and Inadequate Grades (OGRI) as well as the combined figure of "Good or Outstanding" all based on the latest data.

The final column marked "Ofsted 2013 Annual Report" shows the % of pupils in Good or Outstanding schools as shown in the Ofsted Annual Report 2013. We have also included the ranking so you can compare this alongside the latest ranking from Watchsted.

Notes about the underlying data

The source of the pupil counts is the Jan 2013 census ("Headcount of pupils" column from SFR21/2013). Note this is rounded to the nearest 5 and where there was an "X" we have assumed 1 pupil.

The source of the school list and their phases is the Sep 2013 EduBase Extract. Only those schools marked as Open are included here.

The source of the inspection grades is Watchsted (www.watchsted.com). Only a school's latest inspection is considered here. Data was last updated on 10th December 2013.

The denominator of the percentages presented only include those schools (or pupils of schools) which have been inspected. Schools which have not been inspected are ignored.
